



#### 1 FOR YOUR SAFETY

Safety is an essential part of every Vorwerk product. However, the product safety of the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner and its accessories can only be ensured if this chapter is followed.

#### 1.1 INTENDED USE

#### Note!

These devices can be used by children aged 8 years and older as well as by people with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they are supervised and have been given supervision or instruction concerning

use of the respective device in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

Children should not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance should not be carried out by children 8 years old or younger.

#### **KOBOLD VB100 CORDLESS VACUUM CLEANER**

The cordless vacuum cleaner is solely intended for removing dirt and dust within domestic areas. This also includes use for typical household applications in shops, offices and similar work environments, agricultural operations, by customers in hotels, motels and similar living environments and in bed and breakfast operations. The cordless vacuum cleaner may only be used with the corresponding Kobold accessories.

• To find out which carpets, hard floors and above-floor areas the accessory heads are suitable for, please refer to the table on page 9.

#### 1.2 HAZARD WARNINGS

#### Note!

- Read the instruction manual carefully before you use the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner and its accessories for the first time.
- Please pay particular attention to the following information.
- Retain this instruction manual for future reference. It is an important part of the cordless vacuum cleaner and must be kept with it if you pass it on to someone else.

#### Risk of electric shock!

- In the event of damage, contact the Vorwerk Customer Service Centre.
- Never attempt to repair the device yourself. Repairs to electrical appliances may only be carried out by a Vorwerk Customer Service Centre, a workshop authorised by Vorwerk or a person with similar qualifications using original replacement parts in order to avoid hazards.
- Stop using the AC charger if it is damaged.
- Do not insert any sharp objects into the electrical contacts or other openings (e.g. outlet grill, battery pack).
- Do not modify the electrical contacts.
- Never run your Kobold EBB100 Electric Brush over cables on the floor.
- Never clean the AC charger with water or damp cleaning agents.
- Do not use the AC charger in damp environments.
- Never immerse the AC charger in water or other liquids.
- Disconnect the AC charger from the power socket before cleaning.

## **Explosion hazard!**

- Do not vacuum up explosive or readily inflammable substances.
- Never throw the battery pack or the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner into an open fire.
- Only use original Vorwerk battery packs.
- Never attempt to open or repair the battery pack.
   Defective battery packs must be replaced by new original Vorwerk VB100 battery packs.

#### Fire hazard!

- Stop using the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner, the battery pack and electrically powered accessory heads if they have been dropped on the floor and show visible signs of damage or appear to be faulty.
- Do not vacuum glowing ash or burning cigarette ends.
- The Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner and all accessories (especially the battery pack) must never be placed in an open fire or exposed to an external heat source.
- Make sure that the power supply is not covered.
- Stop using the battery pack if it is damaged.
- Never clean the battery pack with water or damp cleaning agents.
- Never immerse the battery pack in water or other liquids.

- The Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner and its accessories are not compatible with Vorwerk mains-powered vacuum cleaner series or their accessories.
- Do not short-circuit the battery pack under any circumstances.

#### Risk of injury due to negative pressure!

Do not vacuum any body parts or hair.
 Do not vacuum in the vicinity of children or pets.

#### Risk of injury from pinching your fingers!

- Keep clear of the moving parts on the accessory heads.
- Always switch the device off before all retrofitting, cleaning and maintenance work.
- Disconnect the accessory head from the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner before performing retrofitting, cleaning or maintenance work on the accessory head.

#### Risk of injury and falling!

- Always place the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner and the accessory head on a level surface when in the standby position.
- Never use the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner to support yourself.
- Never stand on the accessory heads.
- Switch the device off at the main switch before leaving it unattended.

#### Risk of injury due to battery leakage!

- Leaking battery packs must not come into contact with the eyes and mucous membranes.
- Wash your hands and rinse your eyes with clean water.
- If irritation persists, seek medical attention.

#### Risk of injury due to sharp fragments of plastic!

 Do not use the device if plastic components have been damaged due to falling or impacts.
 Protect yourself against fragments with sharp edges.

#### Note! Risk of damage from improper use!

- Only use the specified original Vorwerk products.
- Use the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner only with original Kobold VB100 accessories.
- To charge the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner, only use the original AC charger supplied by Vorwerk in the scope of delivery.
- Only operate the AC charger on a connection that has been properly installed by a qualified electrician.
- Only operate the AC charger with the alternating current voltage and mains frequency stated on the type plate.
- Never carry the AC charger by the charging cable.
- Never remove the AC charger from the socket by pulling the charging cable.
- Do not operate the cordless vacuum cleaner if it is damaged or not fully assembled.
- The Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner is only suitable for indoor use.
- Fully charge your Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner at least once a year to prevent deep discharge, which can damage the battery.
- Do not leave the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner near a heat source (oven, heater or hot radiator).
- Use and charge the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner at temperatures between 5°C and 35°C.
- Store the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner at temperatures between 5°C and 35°C.

- Do not expose the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner or the battery pack to fire, heat or direct sunlight.
- The device may only be used with an original Kobold FP100 Premium Filter Bag inserted.
- The motor protection filter must be installed to operate the device.
- Do not vacuum liquids, damp dirt or damp floor mats or carpets.
- If the filter area becomes damp, dry it before using it again. Replace the Kobold FP100 Premium Filter Bag and the motor protection filter of the Kobold VB100.
- Never clean the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner or electrically powered accessory heads with water or damp cleaning agents.
- Never immerse the device or AC charger in water or other liquids. Never pour water over the device or hold it under running water.
- Do not use the battery-operated device in damp environments (in a wet bathroom or in outdoor areas, etc.) or in places where there is a risk that the device could come into contact with liquids.
- Do not leave the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner running unattended and switch it off after every use.

- Never block the exhaust openings while vacuuming.
- Do not vacuum up Kobosan active or other powdered cleaning agents with the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner.
- Do not use the Kobold 2-in-1 nozzle attachment on smooth or polished surfaces.

#### **GETTING STARTED** 2

In this chapter, you will learn how to set up your Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner. You will get to know the basic functions of your cordless vacuum cleaner and how to use it properly.


Your cordless vacuum cleaner is supplied with the battery and premium filter bag already inserted. Before you can start, you must attach the Kobold EBB100 Electric Brush (see chapter "2.1 Attaching or changing the accessory head" on page 18) and fully charge the battery (see chapter "2.3 Charging the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner" on page 21).

When you first receive your cordless vacuum cleaner, the transport mode is activated. You will need to charge your device before you can switch it on for the first time (chapter "2.3 Charging the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner" on page 21).

#### ATTACHING OR CHANGING 2.1 THE ACCESSORY HEAD

For cleaning floors, you use the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner in combination with the Kobold EBB100 Electric Brush.

- 1. Connect the attachment socket **1** of the cordless vacuum cleaner to the pivot on the electric brush 2.
- 2. Make sure you hear the attachment socket click into the pivot.
- To remove the electric brush from the cordless vacuum cleaner, press the button 3 located at the bottom of the suction piece. Once it is unlocked, you can remove the electric brush from the cordless vacuum cleaner.



# 2.2 STANDBY POSITION AND POWER SETTING

## 2.2.1 SETTING THE DEVICE INTO STANDBY POSITION

#### **A** CAUTION

#### Risk of injury and falling!

The standby position is used to park the device after you have finished working with it or when you take a break.

- Always place the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner and the accessory head on a level surface when in the standby position.
- Never use the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner to support yourself.
- Never stand on the accessory heads.

#### NOTICE


# Risk of damage when the device starts up automatically!

Please note that the Kobold EBB100 Electric
Brush starts up automatically when you take the
cordless vacuum cleaner out of standby position
if you have not switched the cordless vacuum
cleaner off at the main switch first.

The standby position is used for storing your cordless vacuum cleaner, when you are not using it or want to charge it. You can also 'park' it in this position if you want to take a short break while cleaning. In the standby position, the device stands upright and firmly on the floor. You can only put the cordless vacuum cleaner into standby position when it is centred.

- 1. This is done by rotating the cordless vacuum cleaner at the pivot so that both the cordless vacuum cleaner and accessory head are facing straight ahead 1. Now you can set it to standby position.
- 2. Move the handle forward 2 until it is upright and you hear it click into the pivot 3.

i If you put the cordless vacuum cleaner with the electric brush into standby position without having switched the cordless vacuum cleaner off at the main switch, the cordless vacuum cleaner will keep running and the electric brush will switch itself off.



In the power setting, the cordless vacuum cleaner can be moved freely and the device can be steered in all directions on the floor.

1. Hold the accessory head firmly in place with your foot 1 and tilt the handle back 2 so that you hear the cordless vacuum cleaner disengage from the standby position.

Now the accessory head can be moved in all directions again.





# 2.3 CHARGING THE KOBOLD VB100 CORDLESS VACUUM CLEANER

#### **NOTICE**

#### Risk of damage from improper use!


- Use and charge the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner at temperatures between 5°C and 35°C.
- Extreme heat or cold extends the charging time and/or can cause damage to the battery.
- Only charge the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner using the AC charger supplied.

The Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner is not fully charged on delivery. It must therefore be charged prior to initial use. This may take around three hours

## 2.3.1 LED DISPLAY INDICATING BATTERY CHARGE LEVEL DURING OPERATION

The LED display indicates the current battery level of your cordless vacuum cleaner. In order to see this display, your cordless vacuum cleaner must be switched on (see chapter "3.1 Switching the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner on and off" on page 24).

	LED display	Battery level
0	All LED rows lit.	The battery is fully charged.
2	4 LED rows lit.	The battery is approximately 2/3 charged.
3	2 LED rows lit.	The battery is approximately 1/3 charged.
4	2 LED rows flash.	Battery level is low. Please charge the battery.




#### 2.3.2 CHARGING

To charge your cordless vacuum cleaner, proceed as follows:


- 1. Put the cordless vacuum cleaner into the standby position (see chapter "2.2 Standby position and power setting" on page 19).
- 2. Connect the AC charger 10 to the power supply.
- 3. Note the prescribed voltage of 220-240 V.
- 4. Connect the AC charger to the charging point on the cordless vacuum cleaner 2.
- 5. Ensure that the plug is fully inserted.

You can also charge the battery pack separately. For more information on this, see chapter "Charging the removed battery pack" on page 41.



## 2.3.3 LED DISPLAY INDICATING CHARGING STATUS

# 2.4 PREMIUM FILTER BAG, MOTOR PROTECTION FILTER AND BATTERY PACK

Your cordless vacuum cleaner is supplied with the premium filter bag, motor protection filter and battery pack already inserted.

If the LED display 1 lights up yellow when the cordless vacuum cleaner is on, check whether the premium filter bag is full or whether the suction channels are blocked.

See chapter "5 Maintenance" on page 33 to find out how to change the premium filter bag (chapter 5.2.1 on page 35), how to replace or clean the motor protection filter (chapter 5.2.2 on page 38) and how to change the battery pack (chapter "5.2.3 Replacing the battery pack on the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner" on page 40).

# Risk of damage due to closing the filter cover by force!

- Do not use force to close the filter cover.
- The device may only be used with an original Kobold FP100 Premium Filter Bag inserted.
- Never use force when inserting the battery pack.

# 3.1 SWITCHING THE KOBOLD VB100 CORDLESS VACUUM CLEANER ON AND OFF

- 1. Switch on the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner by pressing the main switch 1.
- 2. To switch if off, press the main switch again.




# 3.2 SETTING THE SUCTION POWER LEVEL

The suction power level can be manually set using the silver switch 2 as follows:

	LED display on handle	Suction power level
3	One white LED is lit on the handle.	soft, minimum suction power
4	Two white LEDs are lit on the handle.	med, medium suction power
5	Three white LEDs are lit on the handle	max, maximum suction power

Every time you switch on your cordless vacuum cleaner, it will automatically start operating on the 'med' suction power setting, with the electric brush in normal mode (see chapter "3.3 Cleaning with the Kobold EBB100 Electric Brush" on page 25).



# 3.3 CLEANING WITH THE KOBOLD EBB100 ELECTRIC BRUSH

The electric brush performs equally well on carpets and hard floors.

The electric brush with its versatile functionality can be used on most floors. Nevertheless, please make sure that it is suitable for your floor before using it (see table on page 9).

#### **!** WARNING

#### Risk of electric shock!

 Never run your Kobold EBB100 Electric Brush over cables on the floor.

#### **A** CAUTION

#### Risk of injury from debris flying out!

- Avoid abruptly placing the device on loose, coarse debris (e.g. glass shards), especially at eye level.
- Switch off the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner before lifting up the Kobold EBB100 Electric Brush.

#### **!** CAUTION




## 3.3.1 BRUSH MODES OF THE KOBOLD EBB100 ELECTRIC BRUSH

There are three operating modes for cleaning floors with the Kobold EBB100 Electric Brush. The selected operating mode is shown on the electric brush:

	Brush mode	LED display
	Normal mode The brushes rotate at normal speed. This is the start-up mode. Particularly suitable for hard floors or for gentle brush-suction.	One white LED is lit.
•	Turbo mode The brushes rotate at a higher speed. Particularly suitable for carpets or very dirty areas.	Two white LEDs are lit.
•	Brushes deactivated The brushes do not rotate. Suitable for particularly thick or deep-pile carpets.	LEDs have gone out.
•	Fault: the brushes are blocked.  For more information, see chapter "6 Troubleshooting" on page 45.	Both LEDs flash red.

We recommend normal mode for hard floors.

We recommend turbo mode for a particularly thorough clean and for vacuuming pet hair.



#### SETTING THE BRUSH MODE


The Kobold EBB100 Electric Brush starts up in normal mode. You can set the operating mode using the foot switch **1** on the electric brush.

- Select the correct suction power level for your floor according to the table on page 28.
- 2. Press and release the foot switch 1 to change the brush mode.

  The LEDs on the electric brush show which brush mode you are in.
- 3. Press and hold the foot switch **1** for approximately 2 seconds to deactivate the brush.

  The LEDs on the electric brush go out.
- 4. Press the foot switch **1** again to reactivate the brush.

#### 3.3.2 INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Only use the 'max' suction power level for extremely dirty floors and carpets.
- 2. Always move the device evenly back and forth.
- Never let the device work in one place for a longer period as this could cause damage to the floor.
- 4. The rotating roller brushes can mechanically work on the fringes of the carpet and clean in the narrow gaps. Only pull the electric brush over the fringes backwards, away from the carpet.
- 5. Vacuum parallel to the edges of the carpet.





#### 3.3.3 SWITCHING BETWEEN FLEX/FINE

The 'flex' and 'fine' setting options on the underside of the Kobold EBB100 Electric Brush can be used to adjust the device in line with the cleaning requirements.

We generally recommend the 'flex' setting for normal everyday vacuuming. We recommend the 'fine' setting for a particularly intensive clean (e.g. for vacuuming fine dust from crevices or carpets).




# 3.4 CLEANING WITH THE KOBOLD 2-IN-1 NOZZLE


The Kobold 2-in-1 nozzle is extremely versatile. It has two bristle settings that can be used for different tasks.

#### **NOTICE**

- Do not use the Kobold 2-in-1 nozzle attachment on smooth or polished surfaces.
- 1. Place the attachment socket **1** of the Kobold 2-in-1 nozzle onto the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner.
- For fine dust or delicate objects, increase the length of the bristles. This is done by pressing the green button 2 and sliding the brush attachment outwards until the green button engages.
- For ground-in dirt, remove the brush attachment. This is done by holding down the green button 2 and pulling off the brush attachment.
- To remove the Kobold 2-in-1 nozzle, press the button on the suction piece of the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner and pull the whole nozzle forwards.





# 3.5 STORING THE KOBOLD VB100 CORDLESS VACUUM CLEANER

- When you are not using your cordless vacuum cleaner, switch it off and store it carefully.
- If you are going to store your cordless vacuum cleaner for a long period without using it, you should remove the battery pack from the device (chapter "Removing the battery pack" on page 40).
- Unused battery packs should be charged fully at least once a year.

# 3.6 MOVING THE KOBOLD VB100 CORDLESS VACUUM CLEANER

The Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner has a transport mode so that it can be moved safely without accidentally being switched on.

- Connect the cordless vacuum cleaner to the power supply, as described in chapter "2.3 Charging the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner" on page 21.
- Press both buttons on the handle simultaneously for at least 5 seconds.
   Two rows of LEDs flash to confirm that the transport mode is on.
- You can deactivate the transport mode by connecting the cordless vacuum cleaner to the power supply again, as described in chapter "2.3 Charging the Kobold VB100 Cordless Vacuum Cleaner" on page 21.







The motor protection filter serves to protect your cordless vacuum cleaner from contaminants. To ensure the long service life of your cordless vacuum cleaner, it is important to carry out visual checks and regular maintenance on the motor protection filter.

The motor protection filter can be cleaned as many times as necessary. It must only be replaced if the premium filter bag has been damaged or if the motor protection filter is extremely dirty or gummed up.




### INSERTING THE BATTERY

To insert the battery, proceed as follows:

- 1. Disconnect the cordless vacuum cleaner from the AC charger.
- 2. Open the filter cover as described in chapter "Opening the filter cover" on page 36.
- 3. Push the battery pack from underneath into the open cordless vacuum cleaner until you hear it engage. When doing so, ensure that the battery pack is the right way up. The metal connections 1 should point upwards and the green handle downwards.
- 4. Never use force when inserting the battery.
- Put the filter cover back on (with the motor protection filter and premium filter bag installed) and ensure that it is properly closed.

Every battery has a limited life, as it will slowly but steadily lose its capacity to hold a charge. The cleaning times per battery charge can therefore decrease over time with frequent use.





- Remove any dirt. Remove any hair or fibres that are coiled around the small rollers at the front and check that the rollers rotate freely.

### **ROLLER BRUSHES**

- 1. If threads are coiled around the roller brushes, these can simply be cut with a pair of scissors **1** and removed.
- 2. If a substantial amount of material is coiled around the brushes, remove the brushes (see chapter "5.3.2 Changing the roller brushes" on page 44) before clearing away the threads.

- Remove the right and left side caps **1**.
- Pull the roller brushes 2 and 3 away from the drive shaft.
- 3. Clear away the dirt from the drive shaft 4. Also check the inner central section.
- 4. Clean the dirt off the roller brushes 2 and 3 as described in chapter "5.3.1 Checking and cleaning" on page 43.
- 5. Insert the roller brush with the green end **2** on the left-hand side and the roller brush with grey end 3 on the right-hand side.
- 6. Press the roller brushes onto the drive shaft with a slight rotation until they are fully inserted.
- 7. Check the positioning of the brushes on the drive shaft.
- 8. Push the side caps 10 back on. Ensure that the triangular tab 5 engages in the corresponding slot 6 on the electric brush. The metal should be facing inwards.





If you nevertheless wish to dispose of the packaging, you can do this at any time and without limitation via your local council facilities (waste paper skip, yellow skip, recycling depot, waste paper collection etc.). # 7.4 INFORMATION ON ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION

### 7.4.1 LESS PACKAGING

We only use environmentally friendly material, which is recycled if disposed of correctly. We are actively involved in cutting back on waste packaging during the development stages and are committed to its disposal and recycling.

### 7.4.2 SAVING ENERGY

Vorwerk products protect the environment: they consume little energy yet provide high suction performance.

### 7.4.3 ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY PRODUCTION

We place great emphasis on protecting the environment in the production of our products. We use recyclable plastics and paints. We deliberately avoid using polluting flame retardants. For our filter bags, we use solvent-free adhesives, unbleached paper and non-hazardous plastic. Our instruction manuals are made from materials that come from sustainably managed forests and are bleached without the use of chlorine.

### 7.4.4 RECYCLABLE MATERIAL

The material in our products is almost entirely recyclable. We largely avoid using PVC. When designing our products, we try to use 'unmixed' materials.

The substances used can later be separated accordingly at modern facilities without excessive energy consumption. We have labelled the majority of our plastic components so that they are even easier to recycle.
